She stated that the main theme was stabilizing taxes. She noted that the 2024 proposed budget is showing a decrease in estimated revenues due to an expected decline in construction activity in the Town of Essex. She stated that the 2024 Proposed Budget included a proposed blended tax rate of 5.64%.
